Reighborhood Watch

Welcome! Yes, Summer has arrived. More and more of us are outside working in our yards, running errands and going to work. This gives us the opportunity to observe what is happening in our neighborhood. If you see someone or something suspicious, please call the Police Non-Emergency telephone number. You do not have to give your name although the Police will ask for it.

REMEMBER:

Neighborhood Watch works very well when we all are observant to keep our neighborhood as safe as possible.

NOISE AND LIGHTS

The following products will

make your home less vulnerable to criminals:

One outdoor light is solarpowered, as well as motionsensitive. You can install it without any electrical hookup; it stores energy from the sun

SOLAR LIGHT

- it stores energy from the sun and turns a bright light on any moving object that comes within 75' of it at night. The light lasts for 3 minutes or as long as there is movement in the area.
- 2. LOCKS AND HIDING PLACES
 Keyless locks eliminate the
 worry of losing your keys and
 are impossible to pick. They
 have a calculator-like keypad.
 You punch in your code number
 when you want to unlock your
 home's front door. It's easy

to change, if necessary.

3. TAKE PRECAUTIONS When in doubt, outwit the criminal. Put a key in a phony rock outside your front door or hide your Rolex in a fake can of shaving lotion in the bathroom (from Brookstone).

4. WARNING STICKER Put a warning sticker or sign from a security company on your home (without subscribing to the service). If that seems too obvious, the Sharper Image sells a counterfeit home security control panel that even fools alarm installers.

5. HIDING PLACES Another clever hiding place for valuables is inside a hollowedout book. A book safe costs about \$20 and can store cash, jewelry and other small items.

If you have reported a problem to the Police, it is also good to let your Neighborhood Watch coordinator know for follow-up.


