The homes located on Bokel Drive and Leith Court in Section 7 (near Rt. 50) are separated from the rest of the community by a creek that is approximately 7' wide. There is not a bridge over the creek on our side of Lees Corner Road for walkers, joggers or bikers. A bridge exists on the other side of Lees Corner Road (the Lees Corner School side). The intersection of Bokel Drive and Lees Corner Road is at the peak of a hill. With traffic coming up the hill from both the Centreville Road side and the Rt. 50 side, the intersection is very dangerous because of speed and "blind spots".

Walkers, joggers and bikers from this neighborhood are expected to cross Bokel Drive and Lees Corner Road, cross the bridge, then cross back over Lees Corner Road at King Charles Drive.

The Virginia Department of Public Works confirmed the danger of expecting pedestrians to cross this intersection 5 years ago and approved a footbridge on our side of Lees Corner Road. It has never been built. The Board of Directors is actively trying to get a bridge put in for the safety and convenience that our homeowners are due.

Dear Supervisor Frey:

I am a resident in and a member of Armfield Homeowners Association located along Lees Corner Road in Chantilly, Virginia. I am requesting your assistance regarding the installation of a pedestrian overpass at the creek located off Lees Corner Road between Bokel Drive and King Charles Drive. All of the homes on this side of Lees Corner Road are in the same homeowners association, sharing the same pool and recreational facilities. The absence of a footbridge on this side of Lees Corner Road prohibits the homeowners' ability to walk, jog or bike to their facilities.

Research with the Department of Public Works indicates a pedestrian overpass, such as the one requested in this letter was previously in the planning stages, but was put on hold due to funding. I request your assistance as to the best manner in which to proceed in order that these improvements be made.

The major concern in making this request is the safety aspect involved. Currently, there is a pedestrian overpass at the creek on the other side of Lees Corner Road. Walkers, joggers and bikers from the Bokel Drive neighborhood are expected to cross Lees Corner Road at Bokel Drive, cross the bridge, then cross back over Lees Corner Road at King Charles Drive to proceed to the recreational facilities. The intersection of Bokel Drive and Lees Corner Road is located at the peak of the hill. With traffic coming up the hill from both the Centreville Road side and the Rte. 50 side, the intersection is very dangerous because of speed and "blind spots". Directly opposing Bokel Drive at Lees Corner Road is Hollinger Road. Hollinger Road meets Lees Corner Road at the bottom of a hill and is the site of an elementary school. Hence, there is a volume of traffic at this intersection, including large school busses and vans. Lees Corner Elementary School is located less than 1/4 mile from Bokel Drive, yet all the children are bussed to school because of the safety issue.

A simple wooden footbridge at this site would assure the safety of the children and families in this area. Your assistance in facilitating this would be greatly appreciated. Armfield is managed by Armstrong Management Services, Inc..
